

Instructions for Use

GCS Software Log - MOD Form 703B(Reaper)(GCS)

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1. **General.** The MOD Form 703B(Reaper)(GCS) is used to indicate to the operator the identity of the software loaded into the GCS systems detailed in the Topic 2(R)1. Each sheet makes provision for up to four systems to be recorded.
2. **Insertion and Removal.** MOD Forms 703B(Reaper)(GCS) are to be inserted and removed from the MOD Form 700 in accordance with the instructions for controlled forms on MOD Form 799/1A(Reaper)(GCS). Sheet numbers in the series 0001 to 9999 are to be used. When a sheet is removed the system headings listed and the latest entries for each system are to be transferred to the new sheet.
3. **Compilation.** On a change of software state, the maintenance supervisor is to record the details on the MOD Forms 703B(Reaper)(GCS) by completing the next available line for the system affected as follows:
 - a. **System name.** If a new block is being used enter the system name in the header row of the new block.
 - b. **Program Identification or Mod No.** Enter the Program Identification or Modification number as applicable.
 - c. **Standard (if applicable).** Enter the standard of the software loaded.
 - d. **MOD Forms 707A(Reaper)(GCS).** Enter the SNOW of the MOD Form 707A(Reaper)(GCS) entry raised to document the software change.

The last entry under each system heading on the MOD Form 703B(Reaper)(GCS) is to reflect the current state of software loaded.

4. When a block is full either, continue in the next available block of a sheet previously inserted, or insert a new sheet in accordance with paragraph 2. Once complete and the extant state transferred, completed blocks are to be struck through with a diagonal line.
